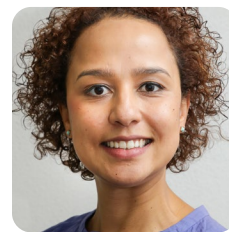

Mandisa Mbali is a Senior Lecturer in Historical Studies at UCT. Her main research interest is in health policy and activism, considered historically, as interrelated phenomena, both transnationally and within South Africa. Dr Mbali has explored this theme in book chapters and journal articles on AIDS activism and policies, health, gender and sexuality and the politics of race and ethics in international health. In 2013 she published her scholarly monograph *South African AIDS Activism and Global Health Politics* with Palgrave Macmillan as part of their Global Ethics series. More recently, her work has turned to historically contextualising the public health politics of COVID-19 in relation to the history of AIDS.
