This collaboration will also contribute significantly to a refiguring and re-establishment of the African Studies archive at UCT after the devastating fire of April 2021 – many of the literary works permanently lost related to the pedagogical resonance of South Africans with Latin America (including Paulo Freirean Pedagogy).

The seminar series will cover, among others, the following topics: comparative studies to develop a common conceptual framework; the concept of (de)coloniality and its meanings in Africa and Latin America; participatory research methodologies; dialogical archives as conceptual framework in further advancing Paulo Freirean thinking and its link to Archie Mafeje scholarship; Knowledge sharing, dissemination and co-design production processes. Each seminar will be recorded online and archived as part of the theorization and reflective practice. A digital interactive online presence of the course for community participation in co-design and feedback processes will contribute to the theorization of 'dialogical archives'.
