

Technical Officer (Full/Part-time) (Pay Class 8)

We invite applications from suitably qualified candidates for appointment to a full/part-time two year post as a Technical Officer in the unit, to commence duties immediately or at the latest by 1 January 2011. More than one part-time appointment could be made. Our ideal candidate should have excellent statistical analysis skills as well as good communication skills.

The Technical Officer will work closely with DataFirst's Manager in ensuring that survey data resources are prepared for use by the UCT community and that Research Data Centre clients and the wider academic community are supported in their use of this data. The candidate will be required to respond to client data queries and work with the software tools used at the unit to manage the data resources.

Requirements include:

- A university degree with some economics or statistics component or equivalent
- Competence in the statistical analysis software, Stata
- Completion of formal coursework in or research experience with survey data
- Good communication skills

Responsibilities include:

- Assistance with data conversion and data migration
- Data and software usage support to Research Data Centre clients
- Assistance with maintaining and updating the unit's web-based data dissemination and data analysis tools.
- Technical assistance with training at DataFirst

The total remuneration package for a full-time post is between R173 622 and R234 875 per annum depending upon qualifications and experience.
