- Third-year students please provide a complete undergrad unofficial academic record/transcript that clearly indicates previous and current subjects and the number of credits per course (third-year subjects do not need to reflect marks at this stage – only credits need to be evident).
- Graduands an official graduation certificate along with the complete academic record/transcript (that clearly indicates the subjects and the number of credits per course) is required.
