Guidelines for pre-proposals to accompany PhD applications to the School of Education.

All PhD applicants need to submit a short pre-proposal document (+/-1200-1500words) with their application. The pre-proposal should address and include the following:

- 1. What is the title of your proposed project?
- 2. What will the research aim to achieve and how do you plan to make this happen? [This is a research question and how it will be answered]
- 3. Why is the research important? To whom is the research important and why is it important at the present time? [This answers the question so what?]
- 4. What other work has been done in this area and what theories have been applied to it? What theory do you propose to use?
- 5. What is the proposed methodology and why is this methodology considered most appropriate?
- 6. Optional: What do you think will be the main intellectual contribution of the project that you propose?
